Facility – Station 5 lot has been planted with soybeans by the farmer.

Administration – I finished applying for the \$177,010 from Will County. We will use the funds to pay back part of the cost of the ambulance we purchased last year.

DEPUTY CHIEF'S REPORT

Jamie Brown stated on May 15th he attended a conference for National Home Fire Sprinkler week. NLFPD was one of three departments to receive an award from NIFSAB for passing ordinance 13 D for residential sprinklers. Highland Park and Bloomingdale Fire also received awards. He presented the 2022 award to Trustee Minger.

Currently have twenty-eight buildings in various stages of construction.

False Alarm fees received \$3,196.00 and \$1,938.45.00 in plan review fees. Land Extraction fees year to date \$20,577.35.

We participated in the Loyalty Day Parade. Marisa assisted Manhattan Fire with Matter of Balance Classes. Our ambulance was on standby at Lincoln Way West & Central's graduation. May our educational Facebook posts reached 10,268 people.
