Firefighter Minimum Requirements:

- \$100 non- refundable application fee
- US Citizenship
- No Felony convictions
- 21 to 35 years of age by application deadline unless otherwise exempt by state statute
- Illinois Basic Operations Firefighter Certification issued from the Illinois OSFM; no other IL OSFM certifications will be accepted
- Valid and current IDPH licensed Paramedic
 Manhattan and Peotone FPD ONLY: Valid and current IDPH licensed Paramedic at time of hire. At time of application deadline (Friday, September 3, 2021 at 5:00 PM) applicant must be currently enrolled in an IDPH approved Paramedic program.
- Valid CPAT certification with Ladder Climb at time of application deadline AND at time of conditional offer of employment (CPAT considered valid for 12 months from issue date)
- Frankfort Fire Protection District ONLY: Residency per Collective Bargaining Agreement at time of hire (presently IL and border states)
- Manhattan, Mokena, New Lenox, and Homer Township Fire Protection Districts ONLY: Residency
 within the state of Illinois

Testing Instructions:

<u>Written Exam:</u> The written examination will be held on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>October 2</u>, <u>2021</u> at Lincoln Way East High School located at 201 N. Colorado Avenue in Frankfort, IL 60423. <u>Doors open at 8:00 AM CST for sign in and you must have a valid driver's license to sign- in. Testing will begin at 9:00 AM CST and doors will be closed- no one will be admitted after 9:00 AM CST- NO EXCEPTIONS. Due to the COVID-19 epidemic, the location and/or format of the testing may change. In the event of such a change, all applicants will be notified in advance.</u>

<u>All phases of testing are mandatory!</u> If you fail to attend or do not successfully complete portion any of the testing process, you will not be eligible for employment consideration at any of the Fire Protection Districts for which you applied.
